- A stronger and more resilient community

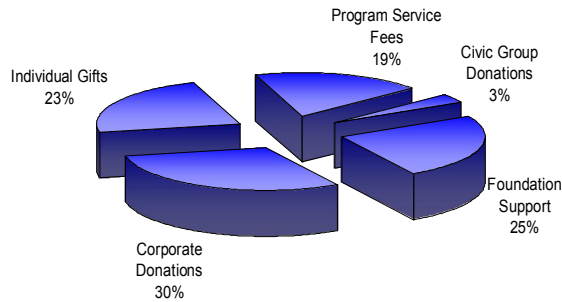
ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN 2005

Statement of Revenues and Expenses Fiscal Year ending December 31, 2005

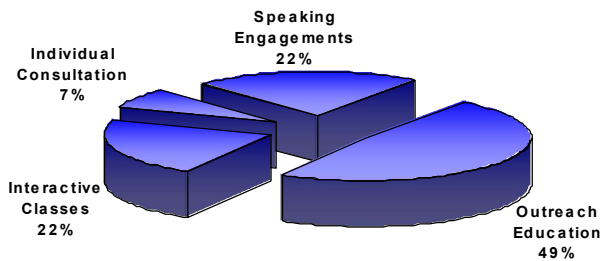
